Board of Directors Meeting
August 19, 2015

A reading of the July 15th board minutes was read and approved by the members present.

The Treasurer's report was submitted by Al Arrison, KB2AYU. Net inflow for the calendar year through August 19th was \$2,708 against expenditures of \$2,956, netting (\$248). Al noted the electric for last month exceeded \$150. Total reported in all accounts was \$14,821.

A membership application was received for a previous member, Charlie Olinda, N2SRQ. It was approved by the members present. A late dues payment was received from Ted Keiffer, N2EEB. It was accepted without penalty because Ted had donated trees for the clubhouse grounds and had been a valuable senior member.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Clubhouse– Al Arrison, KB2AYU, said the clubhouse needed some minor maintenance which would be addressed when the weather cools off. Bill Price, NJ2S, volunteered to replace a faulty motion sensor and investigate commercial mouse traps before winter.

Hamfest – Sheldon Parker, K2MEN, reported the final emailings were ready to go and the PA setup was on target. Volunteer sign ups were organized and day of operational planning was being finalized. Cory Sickles, WA3UVV, planned to make the customary media notifications. All seems to be going according to plan.

Repeater – Al Arrison, KB2AYU, said Ron Block, NR2B, had secured a 2 mtr station master antenna quote which was within budget. He said a good technical assessment would be required prior to antenna installation. He also noted that added filtering may be necessary.

OLD BUSINESS

Jim Wright, N2GXJ, reported that Darrell Neron, AB2E, was in the process of renewing our club license which expires in October.

NEW BUSINESS

Jim Wright, N2GXJ, said he obtained W2MMD field day contact logs from Ken Denson, WB2P, and uploaded them to eqsl. There was discussion about the NJ DX Association note to us indicating postage had been exhausted. It was agreed to send them \$20 to replenish postage.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:47pm.
