Gloucester County Amateur Radio Club General Membership Meeting Minutes Wednesday, July 7, 2021

Meeting opened @ 1933 Hours by President Tony Starr, K3TS with the Pledge of Allegiance

Attendance :

Minutes from the June General Membership Meeting were published previously in the CrossTalk and were approved without modification.

Treasurer : Al Arrison KB2AYU reported YTD Income of \$3,995 and Budgeted Expenses of \$2,439 for a net gain of \$1,556. Approximately \$4,000 is allocated for projects. Receipts for Field Day and Grounding Project Phase I are due. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

Clubhouse : Al Arrison KB2AYU reported that things are in good shape. The new air conditioner is working. The old rotator has been replaced with a loaner from Al; this remains to be tightened up but may be in service following Tech Saturday this weekend. Al noted that the old rotator was full of water, which drained out when it was removed.

Field Day : Vinnie Sallustio N4NYY called this "the best Field Day in years" even though there were a few minor issues with the wine festival and grass cutting. In addition to the great effort by the radio operators we had great support from those who prepared and provided food, Bonus Point volunteers, and the Setup/Takedown crews. **Tony Starr K3TS** noted the good planning and execution, which gave him time to circulate between stations.

Technical Committee : Jon Pearce WB2MNF reminded everyone of Tech Saturday this weekend. There will be several things to see and do including: the new Linear Amp, courtesy of **John Hill W2HUV**, a few satellite passes will occur between 10 AM and noon and images can be viewed from the GOES receiver. A solar panel that is under test has been producing enough power to run the Skunkworks Pi cabinet and will be hooked up to the cabinet at a later time. The VHF Room Lightening Protection Project is on hold until after Summer vacations. On a side note, Jon worked with Lenny Rust W2LJR on a setup that allowed Len to pick up ship locations using AIS when he visited the shore. See Len or Jon if you are interested in trying this.

The Generator : Anthony Cerami KD2RPI reported that restoration of the Kohler generator is basically complete and has turned receipts over to the Club. It fired right up when given fresh fuel and runs much more quietly with the new muffler. Some fine tuning still is required, e.g. voltage regulation.

Winlink : Karl Frank W2KBF said the VARA FM RMS W2KBF-10, that performed well via 2 Meter simplex during Field Day weekend, is not supporting connections over the W2MMD 2 Meter repeater, so this remains "a work in progress".

DX and Contests : Tony Starr K3TS noted that the IARU Radio Championship event will take place this weekend and NAQP is next month. The Bouvet Island DXpedition had been cancelled, but may be back on.

A budget of \$250 was approved by the membership for this project.
