Chris noted that the remote station has been receiving use from 3 recent course graduates and new Club members, which is good to see.

HAMFEST: Jonathan Pearce WB2MNF is working on handouts for Hamfest visitors that will invite them to tour the Clubhouse. **Tony Starr K3TS** will ask **Bill Price NJ2S** to find out if the Boy Scouts can help distribute these handouts. **Jim Clark KA2OSV** reminded the Treasurer that he will need small bills for change at the ticket booth.

TECHNICAL COMMITTEE: Jonathan Pearce WB2MNF said the most recent Tech Saturday was a great success, with over 15 people pooling knowledge concerning the use of Nano VNAs. The presentation following the September General Membership Meeting will concern Digital Networking and the September Tech Saturday will NOT be rescheduled (even though it will be on the day before the Hamfest) but will be a work session focusing on 2 Meter Digital Modes. Jonathan is working on the possibility of recording Tech Saturday sessions and Hamfest Talks for later uploading to YouTube. Jonathan will be away for the October Tech Saturday but will check with **Anthony Cerami N2OAC** to see if he can arrange a tour of the RCA Heritage Museum at Rowan University. As previously reported, the GCARC Grant Application to ARDC was funded and, furthermore, was so well received that ARDC would like to use it as a model for other applicants! We still await the decision from ARRL on the application for \$25k to fund the VHF tower. A decision is expected in September.

OLD BUSINESS: Chuck Colabrese WA2TML asked if there has been any clarification regarding grass mowing in our area. We know that the 4-H has declined to take care of this. Alan Arrison KB2AYU has not heard back from the person who has been mowing, so the matter still is unresolved. Ron Block NR2B circulated the current, recently-revised Constitution.
