Gloucester County Amateur Radio Club General Membership Meeting Minutes Wednesday, October 5, 2022

The meeting opened @ 1932 Hours by Vice President Jonathan Pearce, WB2MNF with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.



ATTENDANCE : In person : 31; ZOOM : 15

Jon noted the recent passing of Ray Martin W2RM, a long-time member and pillar of the Club.

GUESTS : None NEW MEMBERS : Gus Swartout KC3TGB and Frank Reyes KD2ZHA.

Jon noted that four additional new members had joined recently.

The minutes from the September General Meeting, as published in The Crosstalk, were approved.

TREASURER : Alan Arrison KB2AYU reported the following YTD Budgeted Items :

- Income : \$9,933
- Expenses : \$6,005
- Net Gain : \$3,927

Hamfest income of \$2,555 was less than in the past two years, perhaps due to the weather forecast. Half of the insurance bill (about \$900) and the annual mowing cost of about \$1,000 remain to be paid. The cost of replacing the HF tower and new beam antenna was \$9,650, leaving about \$4,500 from money raised via Go Fund Me that can be applied to the VHF project. The Treasurer's Report was accepted.

CLUBHOUSE : Now that the Hamfest is behind us, **Alan Arrison KB2AYU** said we can get back to working on the VHF station and helpers will be needed. **Frank Romeo N3PUU** has added insulation between wall studs and will pick up paneling tomorrow. An 80 meter inverted Vee antenna will be installed on the new HF tower. In summary, the Clubhouse is in good shape.

CLUB NETS : Steve Farney W2SEF reported an average of 12 check-ins to the Tuesday Noon 2 Meter Nets and an average of 13 to the Thursday Evening 2 Meter Nets. **Jim Clark KA2OSV** reported 2 checkins to the Tuesday Evening 10 Meter Net last night and 4 the week before.

DX and CONTEST COMMITTEE : Jerry Barnish K2EAB reminded the Club of the upcoming CQ WW SSB DX Contest on October 29 and 30. Jon said the Club station may be open for this event and, if so, will be announced by email. Also, the ARRL EME contest takes place October 15 and 16.

REPEATERS : Last week **Alan Arrison KB2AYU** and **Chris Prioli AD2CS** checked antennas and feedlines at the Pitman water tower. While not perfect, they were good enough to place the 442.100 MHz repeater back into service.

EDUCATION : Chris Prioli AD2CS said we are now at the halfway point for the licensing classes. There are 5 students for Technician, 4 for General and 6 or 7 for Extra. The issue with PayPal appears to be resolved such that students can now pay for the classes.

- A check for \$25,000 has been received from the ARRL foundation and Jon has begun discussions with local zoning officials regarding the proposed new VHF tower
- Club members can donate 0.5¢ to the GCARF for each dollar spent on Amazon by signing up for Amazon Smile
- The Club has a YouTube channel where we will try to post all future presentations. Help is sought from Club members that have video editing skills
- The Clubhouse has a spiffy new sign that replaces the old shabby one. Also, the Clubhouse has a phone number : **856-244-6914**
- Mark Federici WM2Y asked about the SLACK channel. This has been inactive, so Jon is setting up a DISCORD account for GCARC Project Collaborations
- Jon showed a photo of the test bench that has been set up by **Chris Prioli AD2CS**. A future Tech Saturday will cover use of this equipment
