Jonathan Pearce WB2MNF reviewed the GCARC accomplishments in 2023, including :

- Licensing Classes, with 12 new licensees and 22 upgrades
- A new 160 Meter Loop Antenna
- Two New HF Towers
- DMR and Fusion Hotspots
- New VHF Gear from the ARDC Grant
- Overhaul of the Project Work Area to become a Maker Space
- Rebuilding of the VHF Room and installation of a Mini-Split Air Conditioner
- Meteor Scatter Contacts
- Upgrade of Winlink and EchoLink stations
- A profitable Hamfest, despite bad weather
- RCA Museum Tours
- Digging of trenches and installation of station grounds.

Use of \$7,784 is restricted leaving \$16,393 unrestricted. Between profit from the Holiday Party and donations from fifteen people, for a total of \$3,200, we are almost half way to the \$7,000 needed for the VHF Tower Fund. The Treasurer's Report was approved.

GLOUCESTER COUNTY AMATEUR RADIO FOUNDATION :

The GCARF is a 501(c)3 public charity and contributions are tax-deductible. John O'Connell K2QA reports that, so far, the GCARF has paid for the air conditioner in the VHF room and supplies for the soldering class.

CLUBHOUSE REPORT : Alan Arrison KB2AYU reported that the satellite antennas are back up, with new rotators, so they are "good to go". **Jonathan Pearce WB2MNF** noted that tower bolts have arrived for the VHF towers, some work remains to be done on the tower bases and more donations are needed to fund the VHF towers.

It is necessary for us to become familiar with use of Winlink and the form templates available in Winlink. Also, Bob would like to know if GCARC members would be interested in a tour of the Battleship New Jersey some time in the future.

EDUCATION COMMITTEE :

Chris Prioli AD2CS has not had many people sign up for the next round of licensing classes that begin January 8 (Mondays) for Technicians, January 9 (Tuesdays) for Generals and January 12 (Fridays) for Extras. Sessions are planned in mid-January for building Fox Hunt Offset Attenuators and Tape Measure Beams.

CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE : Ron Block NR2B provided the second reading of the new draft of the GCARC Constitution, which had been circulated previously to the membership. The new constitution was adopted by a unanimous vote.

CLOSING REMARKS :

- Satellite Station (many items)

- 160 Meter loop antenna
- Test Bench Equipment and Supplies
- All grounding copper and lightning protectors
- VHF antenna repairs

In summary, donations are needed in order for the Club to keep doing "new stuff".
