IN ALLITION, ANY PIECE LESS THAN 3 INCHES HIGH (WITE) OR 4 I/4 " LONG IS NON-MAILABLE. ANY OLD SHAPE - (OTHER THAN SOURCE OR RECTANGULAR) IS NONMAILABLE. ## THE DANGERS OF HANDLING T.V. FICTURE TUBES

HERE ARE A FEW HELFFUL HINTS I WOULD LIKE TO SUGGEST IN THE CARE AND HANDLING OF PICTURE TUBES.

- I. ALWAYS BE CAREFUL WHEN REMOVING THE CHASSIS FROM THE CABINET, ALTHOUGH SOME TUBES REMAIN IN THE CABINET.
- 2. THE NECK OF THE TUBE IS THE NOST FRAGILE.
- 3. IN SOME SETS THE YOKE IS MOUNTED IN SUCH A WAY THAT IT IS FASIER TO PULL THE TUBE THROUGH THE YOKE THAN TO PULL THE YOKE OFF OF THE TUBE. BE CAREFUL TO PULL EASILY AND STRAIGHT SO AS NOT TO BREAK THE TUBE.
- 4. WHEN HANDLING A PICTURE TUBE ,TRY TO WEAR SOME KIND OF PROTECTIVE DEVICES SUCH AS HEAVY GLOVES, SAFETY GLASSES AND A HEAVY JACKET.
- 5. REMEMBER THAT THE TUBE MAY BE CHARGED FOR A LONG TIME IF IT IS NOT PROPERLY GROUNDED TO THE CHASSIS AT THE TIME IT IS BEING REMOVED.
- 6. WHEN CARRYING THE TUBE, FICK IT UP BY THE FACE WITH BOTH HANDS AND NOT BY THE NECK OF THE TUBE. TRY TO SET IT IN A CARTON WITH SOMETHING SOFT ON THE BOTTOM TO PROTECT THE FACE.
- 7. I IO NOT WISH TO ALAIM YOU WITH THIS SHORT STORY, BUT AT THIS TIME I FO NOT KNOW HOW TO SAFELY LESTFOY A PICTURE TUBE.

  LAST SUMMER I TOOK A 12 1/2" PICTURE TUBE FROM THE CELLAR AND PUT IT IN A 55 GALLON TRASH CAN AND LECIDET TO BREAK IT SO THAT THE TRASH MAN WOULL NOT HAVE TO HANT LE IT AND POSSIBLY GET HUFT. I PUT THE LIF ABOUT HALF WAY ON THE CAN AND GOT A HAMMER AND THREW ITABOUT 7 FEET INTO THE CAN, THE NEXT THING I KNEW IT WAS RAINING GLASS AND SOME OF THE NEIGHBORS CAME RUNNING OUT OF THEIR HOUSES TO SEE WHAT HAPPENED.
