## COMMENTS OFN PART 97 RULES REWRITE CLOSE

The comment Period closed November 29th on PR Docket 88-139, officially termed the "Reorganization and Deregulation of Part 97 of the Rules Governing the Amateur Radio Service." It seek to update and reorganize the Amateur Radio Service rules "because advances in technology and operating practices have made the current operating rules difficult to apply to modern communications practics." The original comment closeing date was set at October 31, 1988, but extended at the League's request.

KZJF comments...There are two areas of importance to our Club. One is the rewrite of Part 97.107 allows communications support for Public 9atherings where the main beneficiary is the Public. "An amateur station may not be used

logistical support for any sponsoring organization." There seems to be a time between Public service and communications support which may require futher definition. From the way I read it now until further qualified it says

we can not participate in events as the Walk-A-Thons, Bike-A-Thons, Parades etc.

Number 2 worry is Section 97.221....only eleven words long.. The FCC may restrict operations as necessary to Prevent harmful interference. The QCWA (and I am member) gets the impression that it means restricted operation could

be imposed without regard to whether the Amateur Radio operator is causing the

interference or not. The QCWA replied to the Commission "The Proposed rule does not define the term interference; it does not establish fact-finding procedures; it does not specify procedures for determination of the source of

interference; or that such determination be made; it does not specify determination of responsibility for corrective action or the financial responsibility for such action as may be determined necessary; it does not acknowledge the rights of the Amateur Radio Service licensees or that such rights would be recognized by the Commission." In other words at the Present reading if someones electric shaver is causing trouble to your meighbor, and your meighbor complained of interference with their TV the commission can shut

you down without determination of responsibility."

With regard to TVI and interference to your neighbors new\$10 telephone and\$150 VCR, John Johnson(W3BE)(Chief Of Personal Radio Branch) suggests that you work with your neighbor and solve the problem. If your neighbor won't cooperate, or even let you into his house, say so in writing to the Commission if you have recieved a formal notice.

The commission, he said, asks the complainant to identify the interference by looking at a TVI booklet which the FCC will mail out, to help him solve his own problems. In all cases the FCC-EIC will check your station before issuing OUIET hours. De World Radio.

- When you have removed all 15 screws from the crystal oven, you will find that you have opened the wrong one.
- When you go back to assemble it again, you will find three screws missing.

# KENWOOD TH-series HT TNC Interconnection

The following is a suggested circuit for connecting a packet THC to a Kenwood TH-series HT. Included is the TH-21/31/41, the TH-205/215/315/415, and the new TH-25/45 series HTs.

The connections are as follows:

A sub-miniature Plua is used for receive audio. The tip of this Plua is audio out; the sleeve of this Plua is the common ground for PTT, transmit audio, and receive audio.

A miniature stereo Plu9 is used for transmit audio and PTT. Connect the middle "ring" of the Plug to the TNC audio out through a 0.2 of cap (for DC isolation). Connect the sleeve of the Plua to the TNC PTT. The Plua's tip is unused.

Set the TNC audio for 50 to 80 mv audio output into a 2K ohm impedance.

On November 3 President Ronald Regan Signed S.1048, The FCC Authorization Bill which Contains Section 10, The Congressional Concurrent Resolution Supporting Amateur Radio And Its Emergency Communications efforts. While This Resolution, Now Signed Into Law, Dose Not Force The FCC To Retract Its Decision In Docket 87 14 To Reallocate 220 To 222 Mhz To The Land Mobile Service, It May Become An Important Building Block Toward An Eventual Solution.

FCC FORM 610-B EXTENDED

The present FCC Form 610-B, the form used to renew or modify existing amateur club station licenses, has been extended through August 31,1991.Although the forms carry an expiration date of August 31,1988, they will continue to be valid for three years.

DONT MARK THAT LICENSE

Never"take a pencil to"your license or any other officialdocument (Sept 1988, OSTp67). A copy kept for your own convenience could be marked, but always have a few clean copies put aside for modification or renewal of your license. Also, if you get a license with an unreadable call sign, dont throw away the front of the self-mailing envelope! The call sign is printed there too, and it should be readable regardless of the condition of the carbon inside.


### THIRD-PARTY TRAFFIC


