50 YEARS OF A R R L

A paper back book published by the American Radio Relay League reprinted from the special supplements in the 1964 issues of QST. It Relates the complete history of Amateur Radio from the earliest spark days up to the present day state of the art. The publication is available from the ARRL for one dollar.

THE QUEST  
by Tom Allen

This book although not connected with amateur radio, should prove interesting to the scientifically oriented mind of the average ham. THE QUEST is a report based on scientific fact as to the possibilities of life (and intelligent life) existing on other planets in the universe. The first few chapters deal with the necessary prerequisites for life to exist...atmosphere, water, etc. while the latter chapters present facts that are known about the planets in our own solar system. One whole chapter is devoted to a discussion of the planet Mars; its strange canal like features, the melting of it's polar ice caps and the changing colors of the planet which correspond to the changing seasons and very strongly suggest the existance of plant life.

The Quest is Mr. Allen's second attempt at writing and very clearly presents the facts (some very astounding) for and against the possibilities of extra-terrestrial life. The book is available in most book stores at \$4.95.
