FROM: JERRY BARNISH WB2CAK, HAMFEST CHAIRMAN

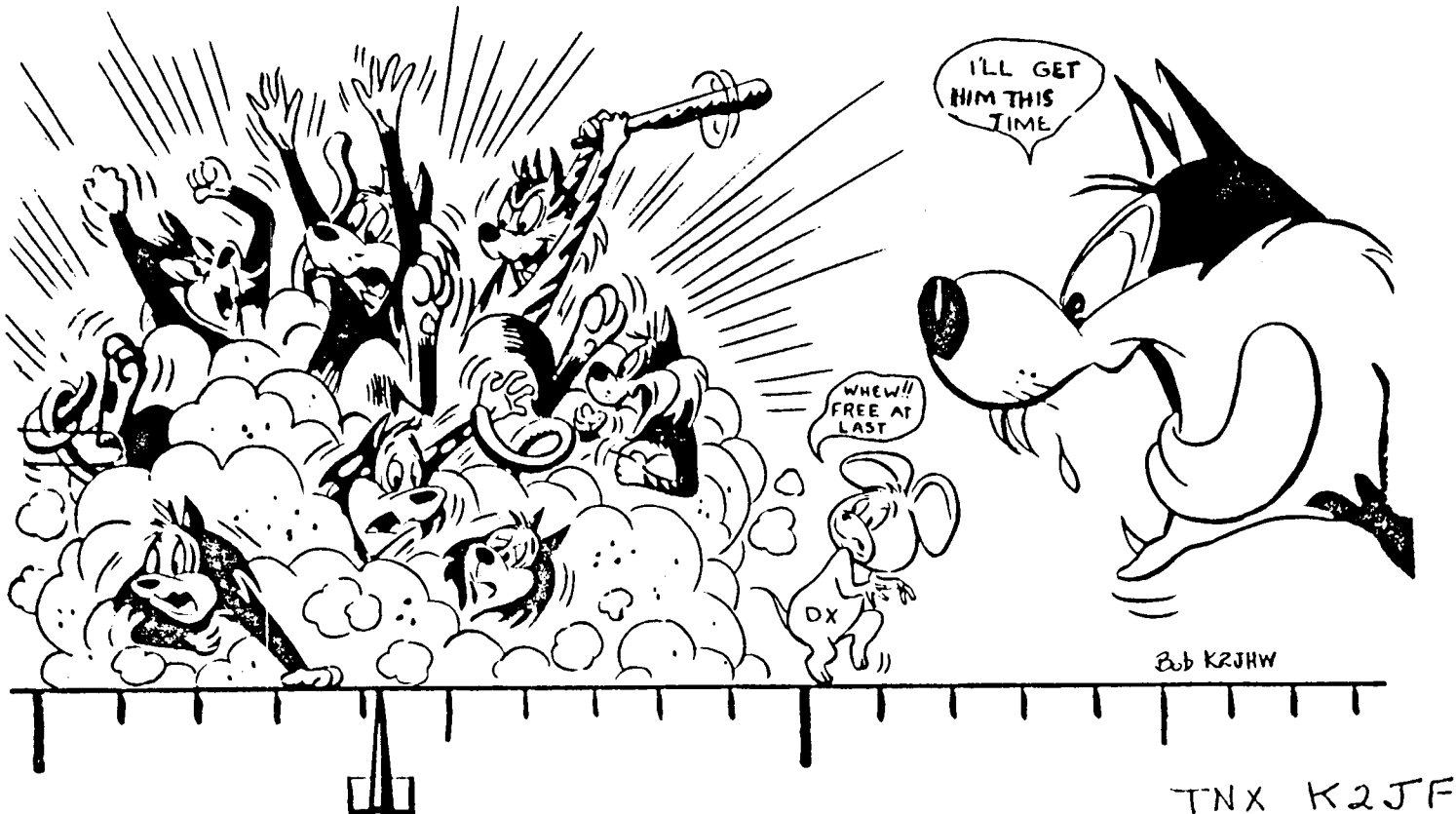

\*\*\*\*\* HANDICAPPED PARKING \*\*\*\*\*

THERE ARE A NUMBER OF BAD APPLES IN EVERY CROWD. I WANT TO TALK BRIEFLY ABOUT THE AMBULATORY DRIVERS THAT INSIST ON PARKING IN DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED SPACES.

TWICE TODAY, I'VE BEEN TO THE LOCAL POST OFFICE. AND, YES, TWICE TODAY I'VE SEEN AMBULATORY FOLKS PARKING IN THOSE SPACES. EACH TIME, I SPOKE BRIEFLY WITH THE DRIVER. I ASKED EACH OF THEM IF THEY KNEW THAT THEY WERE PARKED IN A HANDICAPPED SPACE. BOTH OF THEM SAID YES. THEY BOTH FURTHER ELUDED TO THE FACT THAT THE BUSINESS THEY HAD TO CONDUCT THERE WOULD ONLY TAKE A COUPLE MINUTES. NEITHER OF THESE FOLKS HAD LEGAL HANDICAP ID STICKERS ON THEIR LICENSE TAGS, AND NEITHER WERE HANDICAPPED.

THE POINT IS THIS.. IT DOESN'T MATTER IF YOU'RE JUST GOING TO PARK THERE THIRTY SECONDS OR THIRTY MINUTES. YOU COULD INCONVENIENCE A LEGITIMATE HANDICAPPED DRIVER. YOU JUST NEVER KNOW WHEN SOMEONE WILL NEED THE SPACE.

BE A GOOD GUY. DON'T PARK THERE AT ALL UNLESS YOU HAVE LEGITIMATE NEED TO. I KNOW HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS WHO WILL OCCASIONALLY TAKE NON-HANDICAPPED SPOTS IN ORDER TO LEAVE THEM VACANT FOR THE FOLKS THEY FEEL ARE MORE IN NEED (ie. SEMI-AMBULATORY FOLKS VS. THOSE IN WHEEL CHAIRS.)

ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROPER USE OF THESE SPACES IN PARKING LOTS IS BECOMING MORE COMMON THESE DAYS, AS MERCHANTS ARE REALIZING THE VALUE OF CATERING TO THE HANDICAPPED. THIS IS A GREAT PR BOON FOR THEM. YOU WILL ALSO SEE MORE ENFORCEMENT IN PUBLIC PLACES, AS CONCERNED INDIVIDUALS TAKE STEPS TO NOTIFY AND CALL THE AUTHORITIES TO THE SCENE.
