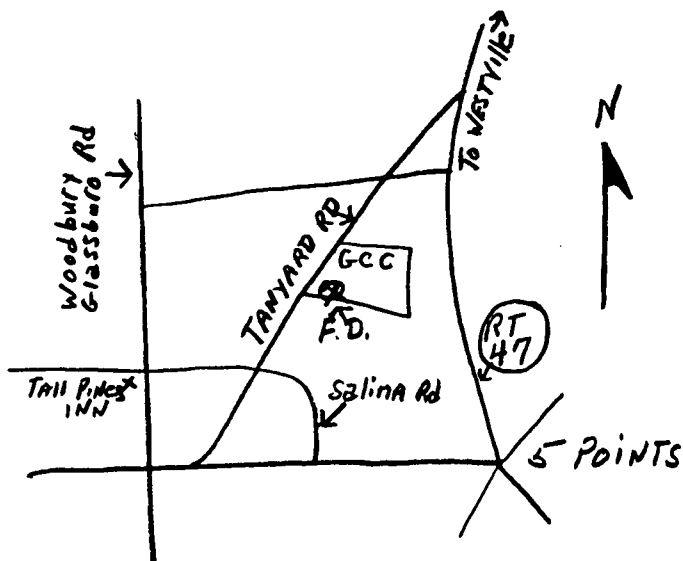
In addition, rumor has it that KE2M's harmonic may set-up a novice station for those raw rookies (we all had to start sometime) in the club.
