## **FIELD DAY JUNE 22 and 23, 1996**

The notice is that I'm moving the weekend after Field Day so the entries will hit the usual change-of-address snag for those who mail them to me. Not to fear as I'm not going far, but there could be a delay of a day or so.

I have been polling everyone who has called for a band as to some ideas for food for the weekend. The general concensus has been to get party platters for Saturday and Sunday lunches, coffee and doughnuts for the mornings, and for Saturday night possibly pizzas, hoagies, etc. That is up in the air still and will probably be finalized on Saturday evening.

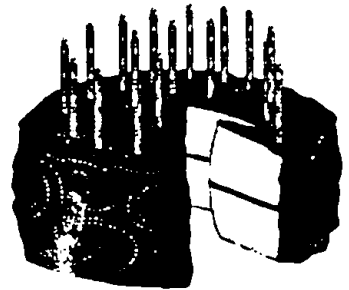

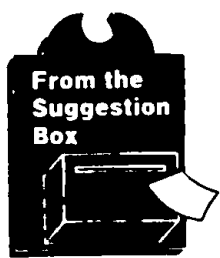
