FOR EXAMPLE: A BROAD OBJECTIVE IN THE CONSTITUTION IS; TO PROMOTE INTEREST IN AMATEUR LADIC. ONE OF THE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES UNDER THIS BROAD OBJECTIVE MIGHT BE; TO INCREASE CLUB MEMBERSHIP. THEN, THE GOAL COULD BE TO INCREASE OUR MEMBERSHIP SOME REASONABLE NUMBER. THIS YEAR.

- 2. FACH GOAL CAN BE REFERRED TO A COMMITTEE (WHICH MAY ALREADY EXIST) FOR ACTION. OUR CLUB WORKS ALMOST FITTINELY THROUGH THE COMMITTEE SYSTEM AND COMMITTEES WITH SPECIFIC GOALS ACT PURPOSEFULLY AND FFFICIENTLY. IN MOST CASES THE COMMITTEE CAN ESTABLISH IT'S OWN GOALS.
 - 3. WHEN A COMMITTEE HAS A GOAL IT CAN PLAN A COURSE OF ACTION. WITHOUT PIANNING. COMMITTEES OFFIATE INEFFICIENTLY, BUT IT IS DIFFICULT TO PLAN WHEN

THE COMMITTEE FUNCTION IS MEMELY TO SOLVE FAOBLEMS AS THEY AKISE. (UNFORTUNATELY SOME COMMITTEES HAVE TO FALL IN THIS CATEGORY)

THESE STEPS DON'T JUST HAPPEN. THEY DEPEND ON COOPERATIVE ACTION BY THE MEMBERSHIP, BY COMMITTEES, AND BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. FERHAPS THE BEST WAY TO FRESENT YOUR ILEAS IS THROUGH "CROSSTALK". NEXT MONTH I HOFE TO ILLUSTRATE THIS PLAN
IN "CROSSTALK" BY SELECTING ONE OF OUR BROAF OBJECTIVES, RESTATING IT AS SEVERAL
SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES, AND THANNING A COURSE OF ACTION TO ANALYSE AT A SPECIFIC GOAL.

BEWARE, I HAVE SEEN OTHER CHGANIZATIONS FOLD UP BECAUSE A SMALL PERCENTAGE OF THE MEMBERS WORKED WHILE THE LARGE MAJORITY JUST SAT BACK, LET(S NOT LET IT HAPPEN HERE.

ONE LAST COMMENT, I MUST AGREE WITH DOUG GHERING'S VIEWS ON THE CODE CLASS AND THEORY CLAS AS EXPRESSED IN LAST MONTH'S ISSUE. THERE WILL BE MORE HAMS REGARD—IT GCARC HAS CLASSES OR NOT. EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER I, FCC HAS CHANGED ITS TROCEDURES FOR THE HANDLING OF EXAMINATIONS SUPERVISED BY VOLUNTEERS. THE EXAMINATION PAPERS WILL BE REQUESTED ONLY FROM FCC'S OFFICE IN GETTYSBURG; TA; BY EITHER THE EXAMINER OR THE APPLICANT, BUT THE FULL NAMES AND THE MALNEST APPRESSES OF EACH MUST BE SHOWN. THE PAPERS WILL BE MAILED ONLY TO THE VOLUNTEER EXAMINER WHO MUST, AFTER NOVEMBER I, BE OVER 21, AND WHO MUST BE A CURRENT HOLIFF OF AN EXTRA, ADVANCED OR GENERAL AMATEUR LICENSE, OR COMMERCIAL RAPIOFELEGRATH LICENSE, OR CURLENTLY THE OUBLATOR OF A GOVERNMENT RAPIOTELEGRAPH STATION. IF THE ATTLICANT SEEKS A CONDITIONAL CLASS LICENSE, THE REQUEST FOR TAIT SHOW THE REASON HE IS ELIGIBLE FOR THAT CLASS; DISTANCE, HANDICAL, MILITARY SERVICE OF RESIDENCE OVERSEAS. THE TEXT OF THE FCC OLIFF WILL ATTEAR IN NOVEMBER OST.

THE LEAGUE ALSO IN OLOSEL THAT VOICE EMISSION ON CERTAIN HIGH FREQUENCY BANDS BE RESERVED TO HOLDERS OF ADVANCED AND AMATEUR EXTRACLASS LICENSES ON THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE. EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1965, 20 METERS. FFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1967, 75 METERS. COMPLETE DETAILS WILL ATTRAL IN NOVEMBER OST.

AT THE SAME TIME? FOR MALE MINOR CHANGES IN THE SCHEDULE, FXEMITION FOR MILITARY RECREATION AMATEUR STATIONS. THE FEES ARE TO GO INTO EFFECT FOR ALL APPLICATIONS FILED AFTER JANUARY I, FOUR LOLLARS FOR NEW AND RENEWED LICENSES, TWO POLITARS FOR MODIFICATIONS, AND TWENTY POLITARS FOR SPECIAL CALLS PROVIDED FOR BY SECTION 12.81. NO FEES WILL BE CHARGED FOR NOVICE LICENSES OR RACES AUTHORIZATIONS.
