## HOW TO GET WHERE WE ARE GOING

THE RECENT LASH OF ARTICLES ABOUT "WHERE WE ARE GOING" STUNNED UP THE AUTHOR IN ME, SO OUT COMES THE OLD FREDERICKS, GARDNER, AND THE HUFF AND PECK SYSTEM.

FIRST, I THINK OUR CONSTITUTION ANSWERS THE QUESTION, "WHERE ARE WE GOING?" VERY NICELY. IT DOESN'T LEAD US STEP BY STEP, BUT IT SETS UP A BROAD BASE TO WORK FROM.

FOR EXAMPLE: "THE PROMOTION OF INTEREST IN AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNICATION AND DEVELOPMENT". PROMOTE MEANS TO ENCOURAGE OR DEVELOP, OR ADVANCE, AND I THINK OUR MEETINGS, PROGRAMS, AND PUBLICITY DO THIS. (AN IMPROVED PLAN TO MEET THIS OBJECTIVE WAS THE SUBJECT OF K2JKA'S ARTICLE)

ANOTHER EXAMPLE: "THE FURTHERANCE OF PUBLIC WELFARE". OUR C.D. AND A.R.E.C. PROGRAMS ARE OUR ATTEMPTS TO MEET THIS OBJECTIVE.

STILL ANOTHER: "FOSTERING EDUCATION IN THE FIELD OF ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION". OUR CODE CLASSES AND TECHNICAL PROGRAMS AND CLASSES ARE THE CLUBS ANSWER TO THIS. ALTOGETHER, THERE ARE SEVEN OBJECTIVES IN OUR CLUBS CONSTITUTION. EACH OF THESE WAS ARRIVED AT AFTER CONSIDERABLE THOUGHT, AND THEY PROVIDE A GOOD WORKING BASE TO HELP GUIDE THE CLUB FOR YEARS TO COME. SO I THINK WE KNOW WHERE WE SHOULD GO; MAYBE THE RIGHT QUESTION IS "HOW DO WE GET THERE?" I'D LIKE TO SUGGEST A PLAN.

1. OUR CONSTITUTIONAL OBJECTIVES ARE VERY BROAD, AND SHOULD BE STUDIED, AND RESTATED MORE SPECIFICALLY. THEN GOALS CAN BE DEFINED WHICH WILL MOVE US TOWARD THE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES. FOR EXAMPLE: A BROAD OBJECTIVE IN THE CONSTITUTION IS; TO PROMOTE INTEREST IN AMATEUR RADIO. ONE OF THE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES UNDER THIS BROAD OBJECTIVE MIGHT BE; TO INCREASE CLUB MEMBERSHIP. THEN, THE GOAL COULD BE TO INCREASE OUR MEMBERSHIP SOME REASONABLE NUMBER THIS YEAR.

2. EACH GOAL CAN BE REFERRED TO A COMMITTEE (WHICH MAY ALREADY EXIST) FOR ACTION. OUR CLUB WORKS ALMOST ENTIRELY THROUGH THE COMMITTEE SYSTEM AND COMMITTEES WITH SPECIFIC GOALS ACT PURPOSEFULLY AND EFFICIENTLY. IN MOST CASES THE COMMITTEE CAN ESTABLISH IT'S OWN GOALS.

3. WHEN A COMMITTEE HAS A GOAL IT CAN PLAN A COURSE OF ACTION. WITHOUT PLANNING, COMMITTEES OPERATE INEFFICIENTLY, BUT IT IS DIFFICULT TO PLAN WHEN

THE COMMITTEE FUNCTION IS MERELY TO SOLVE PROBLEMS AS THEY ARISE. (UNFORTUNATELY SOME COMMITTEES HAVE TO FALL IN THIS CATEGORY)

THESE STEPS DON'T JUST HAPPEN. THEY DEPEND ON COOPERATIVE ACTION BY THE MEMBERSHIP, BY COMMITTEES, AND BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. PERHAPS THE BEST WAY TO PRESENT YOUR IDEAS IS THROUGH "CROSSTALK". NEXT MONTH I HOPE TO ILLUSTRATE THIS PLAN IN "CROSSTALK" BY SELECTING ONE OF OUR BROAD OBJECTIVES, RESTATING IT AS SEVERAL SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES, AND PLANNING A COURSE OF ACTION TO ARRIVE AT A SPECIFIC GOAL.

MONITOR THE A.R.E.C. FREQUENCY FOR CLUB MEMBERS... 50.9 ON THE SIX METER BAND.... COMING NOVEMBER THE 5th. AT 8 P.M. ON THE TEN (10) METER BAND.... A.R.E.C. EVENING TUESDAY...FOR YOU FELLOWS THAT ARENT ON SIX... START ON THE 5th. AND GET ALL OF IT.

ALL I CAN SAY AFTER READING THE OCTOBER ISSUE OF CROSSTALK IS THAT IT IS ABOUT TIME.... ABOUT TIME THAT SOMEONE HAS STOOD UP AND EXPRESSED HIS OWN THOUGHTS. MR. WOOL'S COMMENTS GIVE SOME FOOT FOR THOUGHT EVEN THOUGH I CAN'T AGREE IN FULL WITH THEM, BUT AFTER ALL IT'S AS MUCH HIS CLUB AS IT IS MINE AND YOURS. BY THE WAY, WHERE WERE YOUR THOUGHTS LAST MONTH? I READ CROSSTALK FROM COVER TO COVER BUT I SAW ONLY TWO OTHERS EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS ON A CURRENT SUBJECT. YOU TOO MUST HAVE THOUGHTS ON WHAT THE CLUB SHOULD BE DOING AND WHAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO SEE IT DOING. STAND UP AND MAKE THEM KNOWN OR PUT YOUR PENCIL TO WORK AND WRITE THEM FOR CROSSTALK. NO ONE IS GOING TO BITE YOU FOR EXPRESSING YOURSELF. IT PUZZLES ME TO NO END AS TO WHY THE MAJORITY OF THE CLUB MEMBERS DON'T TAKE AN ACTIVE PART IN CLUB VENTURES, SUCH AS CROSSTALK.

I AM SURE THAT BY THIS TIME THE CHAIRMAN OF THE MONTHLY EVENTS COMMITTEE HAS CONTACTED MR. WOOL AND DISCUSSED SOME OF HIS THOUGHTS, POSSIBLY HE HAS BEEN LASSOED INTO TAKING A CHAIRMANSHIP OF ONE OF THE ACTIVITIES. I THINK THAT YOU MUST UNDERSTAND THE FACT THAT AN UNDERTAKING OF THE NATURE NOW PROPOSED IS NOT A JACK LAYTON PROJECT, NOT A WAYNE WOOL PROJECT BUT A CLUB PROJECT, A PROJECT OF EVENTS THAT 72 INDIVIDUALS SHOULD PARTICIPATE IN.. I HAVE EXPRESSED MY IDEAS, NOW IT IS UP TO 71 OTHER MEMBERS BRING OUT THEIR IDEAS AND FOLLOW THEM THROUGH.

DURING THE PAST MONTH SOMEONE MENTIONED TO ME THAT IN HIS OPINION THAT THE CLUB IS RUN BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS,... WELL IF THEY DO IT IS YOUR OWN FAULT... THESE PEOPLE ARE ELECTED BY YOU TO REPRESENT YOU. TO DO THIS THEY MUST KNOW WHAT YOU WANT. THEY ARE NOT MIND READERS, SO THEREFORE YOU MUST TELL THEM WHAT YOU WANT. IF THEY KNOW AND DON'T FOLLOW THROUGH, THE TIME TO REMEDY THIS SITUATION IS AT ELECTION TIME IN DECEMBER.

I MIGHT AID, WHILE I AM STILL ON THE SOAPBOX, THAT IF WE DON'T START MOVING IN SOME DEFINITE DIRECTION, I THINK THAT YOU ARE WITNESSING THE BEGINNING OF THE END OF GCARC. THIS IS NOT TOONICE OF A THING TO THINK ABOUT, BUT LET'S FACE IT, THERE ARE 20 MAYBE 25 INDIVIDUALS WHO SUPPORT AND WORK FOR THE BETTERMENT OF THE CLUB, THIS MEANS THAT THERE ARE 45 WHO DO NOT CARE OR WHO ARE NOT INTERESTED IN WHAT GOES ON. BY SIMPLE ARITHMETIC THIS MEANS THAT WE HAVE 66% NON-PARTICIPATING MEMBERSHIP. A PROJECT OF EVENTS SEEMS TO ME TO BE A STARTING POINT TOWARD UPGRADING THIS SITUATION. IF WE GET SOMETHING GOING TO INTEREST EVERY LAST ONE OF THE 72, THERE WILL THEN BE NO EXCUSE FOR NON-PARTICIPATION..BEWARE, I HAVE SEEN OTHER ORGANIZATIONS FOLD UP BECAUSE A SMALL PERCENTAGE OF THE MEMBERS WORKED WHILE THE LARGE MAJORITY JUST SAT BACK.LET(S NOT LET IT HAPPEN HERE.

ONE LAST COMMENT, I MUST AGREE WITH DOUG GHEHLING'S VIEWS ON THE CODE CLASS AND THEORY CLASS AS EXPRESSED IN LAST MONTH'S ISSUE. THERE WILL BE MORE HAMS REGARD- IF GCARC HAS CLASSES OR NOT. IF WE CAN GET THESE INTERESTED FUTURE HAMS IN THE DAYS WHEN THEY ARE FORMULATING THEIR OPERATING HABITS, WE STAND A MUCH BETTER CHANCE OF MOLDING GOOD OPERATORS AND AVOIDING MASS PRODUCTION OF LIDS. THERE ARE PEOPLE ASSOCIATED WITH THE CLUB THAT ARE MUCH MORE QUALIFIED TO TEACH THEORY THAN I, BUT WHERE ARE THEY? WHERE WERE THEY AT THE SEPTEMBER MEETING? WERE THEY INCLUDED IN THE 66% MENTIONED A FEW LINES BACK? WILL MORE MEMBERS FOR GCARC INCREASE THE 66% IT SEEMS TO ME THAT CLASSES OF THIS NATURE WILL TEND TO DECREASE THE 66% AND INCREASE THE BACKBONE OF GCARC. THIS IS SUPPOSED TO BE A CLUB VENTURE, LET'S MAKE IT ONE.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN NR 915 FROM APRIL HEADQUARTERS NEWINGTON CONN. SEPT. 19, 1963  
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS:

EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, FCC HAS CHANGED ITS PROCEDURES FOR THE HANDLING OF EXAMINATIONS SUPERVISED BY VOLUNTEERS. THE EXAMINATION PAPERS WILL BE REQUESTED ONLY FROM FCC'S OFFICE IN GETTYSBURG, PA; BY EITHER THE EXAMINER OR THE APPLICANT, BUT THE FULL NAMES AND PERMANENT ADDRESSES OF EACH MUST BE SHOWN. THE PAPERS WILL BE MAILED ONLY TO THE VOLUNTEER EXAMINER WHO MUST, AFTER NOVEMBER 1, BE OVER 21, AND WHO MUST BE A CURRENT HOLDER OF AN EXTRA, ADVANCED OR GENERAL AMATEUR LICENSE, OR COMMERCIAL RADIO/TELEGRAPH LICENSE, OR CURRENTLY THE OPERATOR OF A GOVERNMENT RADIO/TELEGRAPH STATION. IF THE APPLICANT SEEKS A CONDITIONAL CLASS LICENSE, THE REQUEST FOR PAPERS MUST SHOW THE REASON HE IS ELIGIBLE FOR THAT CLASS; DISTANCE, HANDICAP, MILITARY SERVICE OR RESIDENCE OVERSEAS. THE TEXT OF THE FCC CHGTR WILL APPEAR IN NOVEMBER QST.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN NR 917 FROM APRIL HEADQUARTERS NEWINGTON CONN OCT 3 1963  
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS:

APRIL TODAY FILE WITH FCC A REQUEST FOR IMMEDIATE REINSTATEMENT OF AVAILABILITY OF THE ADVANCED CLASS LICENSE TO NEW APPLICANTS HOLDING GENERAL OR CONDITIONAL LICENSES FOR ONE YEAR OR MORE. THE LEAGUE ALSO PROPOSED THAT VOICE EMISSION ON CERTAIN HIGH FREQUENCY BANDS BE RESERVED TO HOLDERS OF ADVANCED AND AMATEUR EXTRA CLASS LICENSES ON THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE. EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1965, 20 METERS. EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1966, 15 AND 40 METERS. EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1967, 75 METERS. COMPLETE DETAILS WILL APPEAR IN NOVEMBER QST.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN NR 918 FROM APRIL HEADQUARTERS NEWINGTON CONN OCT 10, 1963  
TO ALL RADIO AMATEURS

THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION HAS REJECTED PETITIONS FOR REHAERING ON LICENSE FILING FEES SUBMITTED EARLIER BY THE LEAGUE AND SIXTEEN ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTING OTHER RADIO SERVICES. AT THE SAME TIME? FCC MADE MINOR CHANGES IN THE SCHEDULE, EXEMPTION FOR MILITARY RECREATION AMATEUR STATIONS. THE FEES ARE TO GO INTO EFFECT FOR ALL APPLICATIONS FILED AFTER JANUARY 1, FOUR DOLLARS FOR NEW AND RENEWAL LICENSES, TWO DOLLARS FOR MODIFICATIONS, AND TWENTY DOLLARS FOR SPECIAL CALLS PROVIDED FOR BY SECTION 12.81. NO FEES WILL BE CHARGED FOR NOVICE LICENSES OR RACES AUTHORIZATIONS.
