## CLUB MOBILE RADIO UNITS AIDED IN PARADE AND WATER CARNIVAL

Several of the GCARC members were busy on Aug. 18th creating good public relations in the county for us hams. At 11:00 AM Clayton had a parade celebrating their 75th anniversary. Mobile units on 5 meters were Ed WAZELW (in WZMPD's Car), Della WZAFZ, Bob WAZEWF and Woody KZAQL. The Parade chairman rode along with WAZELW at the head of the parade. All cars were equipped with posters of our club emblem.

At 2030 the same day at Lake Garrison W2RJQ Van, W2NMD Mal, WAZUMT Bob, WAZFMO Eric and Tad W2CKK (with operators W2AFZ and K2AQL assisting) provided communications for their 25th annual water carnival.
